Area Agency on Aging Advisory Councils known as TACC:

Represents California's network of 33 Area Agencies on Aging. TACC comes together quarterly to:

- ❖ Learn through the exchange of information, ideas, trends, and exposure to new models of service delivery,
- ❖ Advocate on issues of concern in local/state planning processes, and
- ❖ Strengthen the effective advocacy and leadership skills of local advisory councils.

TACC was established by the Older Californians Act and is administered by the California Commission on Aging. TACC membership consists of the Presidents, Chairpersons, or Designee of each of the 33 Area Agency on Aging advisory councils.
